

TENTATIVE RULINGS

FOR: November 9, 2016

The Court may exercise its discretion to **disregard** a late filed paper in law and motion matters. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1300(d).)

Unlawful Detainer Cases – No tentative ruling will be posted because access to records is not permitted until 60 days after the complaint is filed. Parties **must appear** for all unlawful detainer demurrers, motions to quash, and other matters. After 60 days, tentative rulings will be posted in accordance with the local rules.

Court Reporting Services – The Court does not provide official court reporters in proceedings for which such services are not legally mandated. These proceedings include civil law and motion hearings. If counsel want their civil law and motion hearing reported, they must arrange for a private court reporter to be present. Attorneys or parties must confer with each other to avoid having more than one court reporter present for the same hearing.

THIRD ACCOUNT AND REPORT OF CONSERVATOR; PETITION FOR ALLOWANCE OF FEES TO CONSERVATOR OF PERSON AND ESTATE AND ATTORNEY FOR CONSERVATOR

TENTATIVE RULING: GRANT Petition, including fees as prayed. After a review of the matter, the court finds the Conservator is acting in the best interest of the Conservatee. Based on the report of the court investigator, the court determines by clear and convincing evidence that Conservatee can communicate a desire to participate in the voting process, and therefore orders Conservatee's right to register to vote shall be restored, pursuant to Elections Code section 2209, subdivision (b).

The matter is set for a biennial review hearing and an accounting in two years, on November 8, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. F. All accounting documents must be filed at least 30 days prior to the hearing. The court investigator shall prepare a biennial investigator report for the next hearing date. The clerk is directed to send notice to the parties.

SECOND ACCOUNT OF CONSERVATOR OF FUNDS AND PETITION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTING

APPEARANCE REQUIRED. At the previous hearing, Conservator was to either post a bond in the amount of \$3,111,000 or prepare a Petition to Waive Bond. As no Petition has been filed, Conservator should have posted a bond. Conservator is to file proof of bond before the hearing, and bring a copy of same to the hearing. If no proof of bond is filed or presented, the court will proceed with the procedures outlined in Probate Code section 2620.2, subdivision (c) to either remove or suspend the Conservator.
