GENERAL ORDER OF THE NAPA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT

ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY THE CHAIR OF THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL'S DECEMBER 1, 2020 ORDER

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to health and safety concerns and resulting in substantial operational impediments, and the proclamations of states of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, it was determined on March 17, 2020, April 8, 2020, and April 30, 2020, that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115 were met with regard to the Napa County Superior Court. Upon the renewed request from this Court, on December 1, 2020, the Chair of the Judicial Council determined the conditions described in section 68115(a) continue to exist. Exercising the authority granted under section 68115 and the December 1, 2020 Order from the Chair of the Judicial Council, the Court extends the time period provided in Penal Code section 1382 for the holding of criminal trial by not more than 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the initial or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from December 7, 2020, to January 8, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10).)
