IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THE COURT THAT THE DEFENDANT IS GUILTY OF VEHICLE CODE § 23152(a) VEHICLE CODE § 23152(b) _____. IMPOSITION OF SENTENCE IS SUSPENDED, AND THE DEFENDANT IS PLACED ON PROBATION FOR _____ YEAR(S) UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. Obey all laws
2. Immediately report to Post Court Services
3. Immediately report to the Napa County Probation Department. Obey all reasonable orders of the probation officer. Immediately tell the probation officer if you are arrested or convicted of any crime. If you are in jail, report to the Napa County Probation Department immediately upon release. You must also report to the Napa County Probation Department at least once each month. Immediately notify the probation officer of any change of address or phone number. If you are deported, you must immediately notify the probation officer. After that, and while you remain outside this country, you do not need to report to the probation officer. If you reenter this country, you must immediately report to the probation officer.
4. Pay a \$ _____ fine. This includes penalty assessments and mandatory fees.¹
5. Serve _____ hours days on the Court Work Program in a manner to be determined by Post Court Services.
6. Serve _____ hours days in jail. Go to Napa County Jail at 8:00 a.m. on _____ and follow their orders about serving your time.

7. Immediately report to the jail for booking only
8. Submit your person, residence, vehicle, and property including electronic devices to search and seizure by a probation officer, or any law enforcement officer, at any time of the day or night, with or without a warrant, and with or without probable cause.
 You shall also disclose any and all passwords, passcodes, password patterns, fingerprints, or other information required to gain access into electronic devices or social media accounts under your control as requested by any probation or law enforcement officer. Contraband seized by probation or law enforcement shall be disposed of, stored, or returned at the discretion of the officer.

¹ Payment of the court operations and criminal conviction assessments that are included in this figure are not a condition of probation.

9. Pay a \$ _____ restitution fine and an identical probation revocation restitution fine which is suspended unless probation is revoked.
10. Pay restitution to the victim(s) and the California Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB), in a manner determined by the Court and contracted collection agency, plus interest at 10% per year from the date of sentencing, and

11. Enroll in, pay for, and successfully complete, a counseling or education program if required by the probation officer.
12. Enter and complete the Community Corrections Service Center program, depending on outcome of the program assessment, abide by all of the program's rules and regulations, if the assessment concludes you do not meet Community Corrections Service Center requirements, or treatment is not necessary, you will not be required to do so.
13. Report to Probation for an alcohol/drug assessment.
14. Enroll in, pay for, and successfully complete an outpatient or residential treatment program, depending on the assessment outcome. Abide by all of the program's rules and regulations. Do not leave the program without the probation officer's permission. If the assessment concludes neither type of treatment is necessary, you will not be required to do so.
15. Immediately enroll in, pay for, and successfully complete the Theft Awareness Program.
16. Immediately enroll in, pay for, and successfully complete Alternatives.
17. Attend a 12-step program at least _____ times a week.
18. Do not use, consume or possess any non-prescribed or illegal substances (or cannabis unless specifically authorized by the Court). Provide the probation officer with verification of any prescribed controlled substances within 72 hours of it being prescribed.
19. Do not drink or possess alcoholic beverages
 except in the course and scope of employment.

20. Do not operate a motor vehicle with a measurable amount of alcohol or THC in your system.

21. Submit to a blood, breath, or urine test if requested by any law enforcement or probation officer. If suspected of driving with a measurable amount of alcohol or THC in your system.

22. Immediately enroll in, pay for, and successfully complete a licensed DUI program for 6 weeks

24. Do not operate a motor vehicle unless it is equipped with a functioning, certified ignition interlock device. This restriction will last for 1 year 2 years 3 years from today. You may not drive any vehicle without a valid driver's license.

26. Pay a Penal Code § 1203.097(a)(11)(A) fee of \$200 \$_____ to the battered women's shelter

27. Do not own or possess any firearm, ammunition, or other weapon

28. Immediately enroll in, pay for, participate in, and successfully complete a batterers' intervention program chosen by the probation officer. Length of program will not be for less than one year unless an alternative length is established by a validated risk and needs assessment administered by the probation department pursuant to Penal Code § 1203.099. File proof of enrollment with the court, and the probation officer within 30 days.
