GOVERNOR NEWSOM NOMINATES THE HON. MONIQUE S. LANGHORNE FOR THE COURT OF APPEAL

NAPA, CA—Governor Gavin Newsom announced yesterday his nomination of Judge Monique S. Langhorne as a Court of Appeal Justice to the First District Court of Appeal. If confirmed, Judge Langhorne will be only the second Napa County judge elevated to the Court of Appeal.

The Governor's Office released the following statement: "Judge Monique Langhorne Wilson, of Solano County, has been nominated to serve as an Associate Justice of the First District Court of Appeal, Division One. She has served as a Judge at the Napa County Superior Court since 2018. Judge Langhorne Wilson served as a Commissioner at the Napa County Superior Court from 2006 to 2018. She served as a Deputy District Attorney at the Napa County District Attorney's Office from 2000 to 2006 and was a Family Support Officer at the Napa County Department of Child Support Services from 1999 to 2000. Judge Langhorne Wilson earned a Juris Doctor degree from the University of California, Berkeley School of Law."

"I'm thrilled with Judge Langhorne's historic nomination to the Court of Appeal. She has served our Court with distinction since 2006 and will make an outstanding justice," said Presiding Judge Cynthia P. Smith. Judge Langhorne added, "It's been a true honor to serve the people of Napa County and I look forward to my confirmation hearing and being able to contribute even more as an appellate court justice."
