NAPA HISTORIC COURTHOUSE ONE OF THREE ICONIC BUILDINGS FEATURED IN NAPA LIGHTED ARTS FESTIVAL

NAPA, CA – For the eighth time since 2017, the Napa Lighted Arts Festival has returned to downtown Napa with the historic courthouse serving as one of three iconic buildings hosting projection artwork.

The Napa Lighted Art Festival is a celebration of creative arts, technology and lights, and supports innovative techniques using light and light technologies as a growing art medium. This walkable outdoor experience is **free** in Downtown Napa and features 15 lighted art installations over a five-week period from January 17 through February 15, 2026. Projection artwork will be displayed on three iconic downtown buildings, to include the historic courthouse, for the first 9 nights of the festival (note: the courthouse will feature artwork through January 25). The Napa Historic Courthouse, built in 1878, stands as a symbol of the area's judicial history and architectural heritage
