NAPA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT HONORS JURORS THROUGHOUT THE MONTH OF MAY

NAPA, CA – To recognize the vital role community members play in the justice system, the Napa County Superior Court is expanding Juror Appreciation Week (May 11–15) into a month-long celebration starting this year.

While the California Legislature officially established the second week of May as a time to acknowledge juror contributions in 1998, Napa County is extending its thanks to the entire month. Residents reporting for service throughout May will receive a special token of appreciation from the court.

“Jury Service is the bedrock of our legal system and the foundation of a just society,” said Presiding Judge Scott R. L. Young. “We are grateful for all who come forward to serve their community and fulfill their duty.”

If you have been summoned to appear for jury duty during the month of May, you can anticipate receiving a token of appreciation for your time, commitment, and support.

As a reminder, members of the public are randomly selected to serve. If you are called in as a prospective juror, you should plan to be available for the entire week. If selected as a juror, you will serve to the end of the jury trial.
