## **GOVERNOR NEWSOM APPOINTS VERONICA JUAREZ AS NAPA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT JUDGE**

NAPA, CA—Governor Gavin Newsom announced earlier today the appointment of Veronica Juarez to a judgeship in the Napa County Superior Court. She fills the vacancy created by the retirement of the Honorable Mark S. Boessenecker.

The Governor's Office released the following statement: "Veronica Juarez, of Yolo County, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the Napa County Superior Court. Juarez has served as a Deputy District Attorney at the Napa County District Attorney's Office since 2021. She served as a Deputy Attorney General at the California Department of Justice from 2019 to 2021. Juarez served as a Deputy District Attorney at the Solano County District Attorney's Office from 2007 to 2019. She served as a Deputy Public Defender at the Yuba County Public Defender's Office from 2004 to 2007. Juarez received a Juris Doctor degree from the University of San Francisco School of Law."

We are delighted by the Governor's appointment of Veronica Juarez to the Superior Court bench, where her extensive legal experience and unwavering integrity ensure she will serve with excellence for years to come", said Presiding Judge Scott R. L. Young. Assistant Presiding Joseph Solga added: "We're elated that DDA Juarez has been appointed as a Superior Court Judge. She has served the legal community for over two decades and brings exceptional experience to the Court."

Ms. Jaurez, who is expected to take the oath of office later this month and assume her bench assignment shortly thereafter, remarked, "I am truly honored and humbled to serve the citizens of Napa. I am grateful to Governor Newsom for his confidence in my abilities to serve in this important role. I look forward to upholding the law with integrity, fairness, and understanding."
