This letter is written as a response from the Napa Valley Unified School District to an investigation and subsequent recommendations provided by the Napa County Grand Jury in its 2007-2008 report.

The district is in agreement with the Grand Jury's recommendations related to the Napa County Office of Emergency Services. Napa Valley Unified School District is responding to Recommendation #1 C.E.R.T. training be implemented in Napa County high schools and middle schools. A Federal Readiness and Emergency Management for School Grant has been awarded to Napa County Office of Education with a start date of July 1, 2008 and an ending date of January 1, 2010. This grant calls for TEEN-CERT Training for 300 middle/high school students beginning in November of 2008.

I very much appreciate the two-way approach that the Grand Jury has taken to this issue. The result has been improved communications with key stakeholders and better support for our students.
