
ORDER VACATING ORDER RE:  
EXTENSION OF  
RESTRAINING/PROTECTIVE ORDERS

The standing order issued by the Napa Superior Court on April 8, 2020, regarding extension of restraining/protective orders, is hereby vacated.

The April 8, 2020 order being hereby vacated was issued in response to Emergency rule 8 of The Amendments to the California Rules of Court, adopted by the Judicial Council on April 6, 2020. On April 20, 2020, the Judicial Council amended Emergency rule 8 to delete automatic extensions of restraining orders set to expire during the state of emergency and to alternatively require courts to provide, during this time, a means for the filing of requests to renew restraining orders. Pursuant to these amendments, this Court's April 8, 2020 is vacated nunc pro tunc to the date of issuance, such that it has no impact whatsoever on any restraining orders. The Napa Superior Court has provided and continues to provide a means for the filing of requests to renew restraining orders through the ex parte process currently in place.

It is so ordered.
